Full day is from 9:00am-2:00pm, Half day is from 9:00am- 12:30pm Drop off begins at 8:45am Preschool ends at 2:00pm on Friday.

A nutritious snack and hot lunch is served daily to all children, covered by tuition.

10% discount will be applied to siblings.

A \$1000 non refundable deposit is due upon enrollment that will be counted towards the June tuition. This Check should be dated August 1 2014

There is a one time diaper fee for children in diapers. Of \$100 Diaper fee should be added to first tuition check.

The annual tuition fee (less the deposit) is divided into 10 Segments. Ten post-dated checks dated for the first of each month from Septmeber 2014 through June 2015 is due upon enrollment. Checks should be made out to Chabad of Dumbo. Children cannot begin school until tuition checks are received. The checks will be deposited on the 1st of each month.

Aftercare will be available from 2:00 - 4:00 pm Monday - Thursday.

Children who attend aftercare may join us, provided there is space, for \$10 per hour. However, arrangements and payments must be confirmed at the beginning of each month.

Please note that financial assistance is available. No child will be turned away due to the lack of funds. Please let us know if you need a scholarship form.

Tuition is an annual fee and there are no credits or make up days for illness, holidays or family vacations.

Refund Policy

Deposits are non refundable.

Withdrawal before June 30, 2014 Complete refund, less the deposit.

Withdrawal before August 1, 2014 Complete refund, less the deposit and 3 months tuition.

Withdrawal before September 1. 2014 Complete refund. less the deposit and 4 months tuition.

Withdrawal after September 1, 2014 A pro-rated refund, less the deposit and 6 months tuition.
